By fine tuning the characteristics of the course, including the removal of trees, it is sure to please. "The removal of select trees was the first step in the process of creating an experience that allows the course to come to life, with subtly rolling fairways and native grasses. With the links style changes you can see up to fifteen (15) different greens on different parts of the golf course," said Barry Owens, GM. The course will mature into a true inland Links style course. All rough areas have been cleaned up and seeded with a variety of fescue grasses. These grasses will continue to mature and grow. Care will be taken to control thickness to provide challenging, but playable conditions. There's even a walking

and designated family day in the works, not unlike at golf's most historic Links golf course, St. Andrews in Scottland.

Sustainability is a key ingredient to providing an award-winning golf experience at Treetops Resort. New energy efficient golf carts, hybrid mowers, new water saving methods and climate friendly applications will provide a state-of-the-art yet sustainable golf experience for generations to come.

And the Treetops team is not stopping there in this season's offerings for the golf enthusiast and resort guests. The north pro shop has been moved to the second floor.
