Did you know....

On July 30th, 2001, in Gaylord Michigan, Golf Legends Paul Azinger, Raymond Floyd, Phil Mickelson, and Lee Trevino descended upon Treetops Resort to take part in the 3rd Annual Par 3 Shootout Event which aired on ESPN. Threetops, a 9-hole par 3 course, was in its 10th year as thousands of golfers from all around the world came to play.

The competition was a friendly skins game with some twists and a total purse of \$540,000 was up for grabs. In addition, each hole was insured for \$1,000,000 if any of these talented players knocked one in for an ace.

On the 7th hole, "High Five," Trevino was the 3rd to hit. He stepped up to the tee in front of a hushed crowd surveying his 138-yard shot. Immediately after his swing, he exclaimed, "It's gotta get down!" and he was right. The ball pitched about 3 yards over the green and into the rough. However, the well struck shot had plenty of "tour sauce" and spun back onto the putting green and rolled some 30 feet right back into the hole!

This was the first and only ace in the history of the Par 3 Shootout at Treetops and accomplished by one of the greatest ball strikers to ever play the game. For this feat, he earned \$10,000 for closest to the pin, another \$80,000 for the skin, and capped that off with the \$1,000,000 for the ace. Mr. Trevino made the call to donate half of those winnings to St. Jude's Children's Hospital.

Fast forward to today. As you sit and review this menu you can look up and out to the same courses where legends have walked and where legends were made. Maybe you will be the next.
