PLATEAU

Try to keep tee shot below the hole. Green slopes from back to front. With right pin location, use slope on right side of green to feed ball to hole.

2

GD=29

DOUBLE CROSS

(Left green) Do not miss your tee shot left. Select shot to any pin is right of the front bunker. (Right green) Be aware of the false front. Green slopes severely from right to left. Play shot right of any pin location.

3

GD=35

DEVIL'S DROP

137
211 207 219

Check wind! Take as many as four clubs less than yardage, this is the largest elevation change at 11 teetops. Missing short is better than long.

4

GD=22

DECEPTION

86 97 106
140 168

Take elevation change into consideration. Green slopes from front to back and right to left. Shots that miss short or right may get a favorable bounce. Left of the green is trouble.

5

GD=30

VALLEY LO

105 135
150

One of the few holes that plays uphill. The green is divided into two sections by a large tier. Shots that land in the middle of the green will come back towards the front.

6

GD=19

HARRY'S WAY

82 78 88
107 131 147 169

The green is divided into two sections, left and right. Tee shots that come up short may find the water or bunker. Balls hit to right side of green may not check.

7

GD=34

HIGH FIVE

130 135 150

Check wind! Take up to three clubs less for this tee shot. The green slopes significantly from back to front. Try to tie Mr. Trevino's famous ace!

8

GD=18

HANG TIME

103 117
124 140

This hole also plays downhill. Avoid hitting your tee shot short and right.

9

GD=23

UPWARD HOME

125 135 140

Add at least a half of club for this tee shot. Bunkers will catch shots that come up short of the green.
