

1 Favor your tee shot to the right side. On your second shot, favor the left side whether you decide to go for it or lay up.

2 Plays a bit longer than the yardage; avoid being short or right.

3 Drive to the right center is best. Fairway narrows significantly from 150 yards and in, with a hidden ravine looming on the left. Green complex is very narrow and slopes away on both sides.

4 The original Jones design has been resurrected giving this hole the teeth it once had. Plays at least one club longer due to the uphill elevation change. Be sure you have enough to carry the bunkers.

5 Smart play may be a 3-wood or a hybrid off the tee. Second shot can be a challenge; going right is dead while going left will result in a steep uphill shot to the green.

6 The hole that put northern Michigan golf on the map. Depending on the wind, you may use up to 3 or 4 clubs less for this shot.

7 Drive right center for best approach shot in. The second shot can play up to 2 clubs longer than the distance.

8 Unless you plan to hit it over the corner on the right, you may want to hit a 3-wood or hybrid off the tee.

9 Drive left center to avoid bunkers. Second shot plays 1-3 clubs longer depending on the pin location.

LOCAL RULES AND INFORMATION

1. Please use care at all times. You will be held responsible for damage incurred to the course or your cart.
2. Restrooms are found after playing holes 5, 11, & 14.
3. When siren is sounded please evacuate the course immediately and go directly to the clubhouse or shelter.
4. Never hit a shot unless you are sure the players in front of you are out of range.
5. The scorecard provides several tee options for your enjoyment. Choose the tees that best match your ability.
6. Food and Beverage Service provided at clubhouse, via beverage cart, and at halfway house after hole 11.
7. We ask that you adhere to our 4:45 pace of play and/or keep pace with the group in front of you.


10 It will take three solid shots to get you home on this long par 5. Favor the right side on your first two shots. 


11 Drive to the right center. Use 2 to 3 extra clubs on your second shot and do not be short on the approach shot. 


12 Favor the right side on your drive and then a long second shot in awaits. 


13 If pin is left, be sure you have enough club to land on that level of the green. 

14 Keep driver in the bag and lay up short of ravine. Left center in the fairway is the best approach to this narrow green. 

15 A short risk/reward par 4 that long hitters can reach. If laying up favor the right center. If going for it, favor the left. 

16 Favor the left side of this short par 3. Wind may be tough to detect but will affect your ball flight. 

17 Hole sets up to entice you to cut the corner on the right but that is deceptive. The safest play is to the left of the bunkers. 

18 Drive right center is best. If going for the green, favor the right side. If laying up, it may make sense to lay back at 120-140 yards (especially if pin is front).
